
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The objective is to achieve a high level of sustainable income and stability of capital invested.

INVESTMENT POLICY

In order to achieve the objective, the portfolio will be actively managed and will continually reflect the portfolio manager's view of the relative attractiveness of the various asset classes. The portfolio will be managed in compliance with prudential investment guidelines for retirement funds in South Africa to the extent allowed for by the Act, subject to a maximum equity exposure of 10% of the portfolio's net asset value. Investments to be acquired for the portfolio may include equity securities, property securities, property related securities, interest bearing securities, non-equity securities, money market instruments, preference shares and assets in liquid form. The portfolio may also invest in participatory interests and other forms of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments.
