

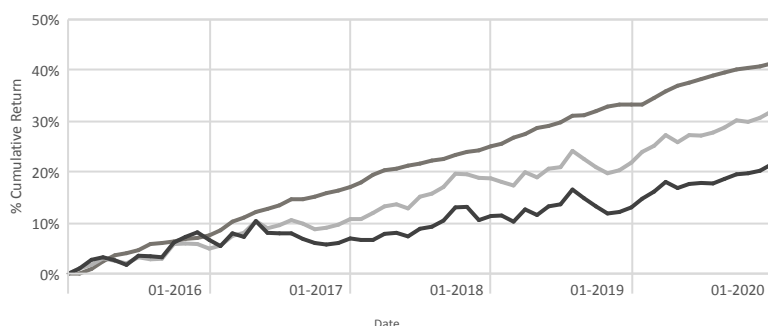
INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE

The primary objective of the Renaissance BCI Cautious Fund is to provide investors with a high level of income and stable capital growth.

INVESTMENT UNIVERSE

Investments may comprise a combination of assets in liquid form, money market instruments, interest bearing instruments, bonds, debentures, corporate debt, equity securities, property securities, preference shares, convertible equities and non-equity securities. The manager may invest in participatory interests or any other form of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes. The portfolio may invest in financial instruments. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions. Equity exposure may be as high as 40%. The manager shall reserve the right to close the portfolio to new investors. This will be done in order to manage the portfolio in accordance with its mandate.

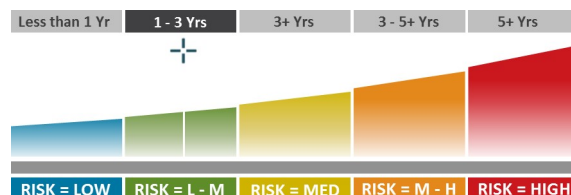

Low - Medium Risk
